different games and valuable books on healthcare and yoga. This certainly inspires and encourages students to make their career in the sports. This type of library is certainly a unique set up not found anywhere in VNSGU affiliated colleges.

- From the total students' Council Fund 50% budget is allocated to sports activities.

### (3) The Practice :

- With a massive strength of 3000+ students, the college tries its best to provide opportunities to each student interested in sports. A fair selection strategy is uniformly implemented and funds are utilised to coach the students.
- As the healthiest best practice, the college emphasises on physical health leading to mental health as well as inculcating sportmanspirit.
- Girls are given special attention and broadened opportunities made available to them.
- Counselling and convincing parents to allow girls to participate in events is also a major task of the sports coach.
- Health nutrition and diet guidelines also provided to the students which helps to enhance their performance.

#### **(5) Problems Encountered and Resources :**

- As this field requires latest sports equipment, need for funds will always remain a big constraint.
- Maintenance also requires big amount hence the college faces shortage of funds.
- With a massive strength of 3000 + students, the college needs additional sports teacher, so that personal coaching can be given to each sports student.
- The college needs to have more badminton courts and apparatus to accommodate more students.

#### **2. Scholarship to Economically weak students in open category.**

The college is situated in the heart of city and hence is easily accessible to students coming from remote village which are approximately 20 to 80 kms. away from Surat. The students coming from these remote rural areas, hail from very mediocre families. It should be noted that the government grant covers only SC, ST, OBC category and hence students in open category do not get any financial aid. Government has started scholarship for EWS students recently. But this college is following this noble practice since years.

#### **Objective:**

- To provide an equal opportunity to financially weaker section students from open category.
- To help them to survive with respect and dignity which enhance their employability for life time.

#### **The context**

The college has identified need to provide scholarship to students who are from open category coming from economically weaker section. Since there is no provision of any scholarship to open category students and remain neglected part for years together so we establish a healthy tradition to provide scholarship to needy and desirous to get education. Out of the total strength of students, numerous students require financial aid in the open category. Hence the institution has formed a transparent system to allocate funds from Student Teachers welfare fund. The uniform policy is followed where each applicant has to fill the form and has to attach proof of income below Rs.1,50,000/- p.a.

#### **The Practice**

- The uniqueness of the practice is that the institution reimburses a pro rata amount to each student falling under this category.
- The student Teachers welfare Aid committee scrutinizes all applications and thereafter decides the

amount to be reimbursed their fees from the fund to each student whose family income is below Rs.1,50,000/-p.a.

- This healthy practice ensures that a student completes graduation and seeks employability and earnings for the future.

### **Evidence of success**

Imbibing the philosophy of "Sarva Siksha Abhiyan", this year the college aided 301 students in the open category of which 177 were girl students, 130 male students. In totality, the amount reimbursed was Rs.3,28,500/- which is a significant move towards aiding economically weaker students in the open category.
